**4. Vendor Responsibilities - The River Rouge Days Committee provides only the contracted booth space.**

Vendors must provide their own: Tents, Tables and chairs, Extension cords, Lighting, Equipment and appliances. **No water hook-ups are available.**

Electricity is limited. Vendors must provide their own grounded (3-prong) extension cords. The City and the Rouge Days Committee do not guarantee continuous electrical service and are not liable for damage due to electrical issues or misuse.

**5. Insurance & Health Requirements**

Liability Insurance (Required for All Vendors) A Certificate of Insurance must be submitted with this application showing:

- Minimum \$300,000 single limit coverage
- Product liability coverage (if applicable)
- The City of River Rouge and River Rouge Days Committee listed as Additional Insured
- Failure to provide insurance documentation will result in denial of participation.
- Health Department (Food Vendors Only)

**All food vendors must:**

- Obtain proper inspection and licensing from the Wayne County Board of Health
- Pay all required Health Department fees
- Be present for inspection at Memorial Park (Friday afternoon)

Any violation of Wayne County Health regulations may result in immediate removal from the event without refund.

**6. Clean-Up Policy**

Vendors are responsible for maintaining a clean booth area throughout the event. Booths must be cleaned daily. Failure to do so may result in a \$100 per day cleaning fee OR removal from the event without refund.

**7. Agreement & Signature**
